Call to order: 7 pm by Interim Chairperson Linda McCaughin.

Approval of minutes of June 10th: A motion to approve the
minutes was made, seconded and approved.

Treasurer's report: JoAnn Graham reported a balance of
\$7973.12. Details are posted on our web site.

Committee reports:

- **ICC:** Robert Prieffer reported on the highly successful
Grand Opening and Yard Sale of July 3rd. An estimated 1000
people attended, and approximately \$1700 was made. There
were many expressions of approval and support among those
attending.

trailer, 3) Robert expressed concern regarding the need for
ongoing maintenance, and will speak to Vic about this, 4) the

possibility of obtaining a surveillance system for the site is being explored.

- **Speaker Series:** Chris Singer reported she will be in charge of coordinating the series. A funding grant will be applied for, and three speakers have been tentatively lined up.

New Business:

Vice-Chairperson: Dawn Sonnier was nominated and unanimously elected to be Vice-Chairperson for a term of 2 years.

Other:

- Chris reported that the ICRC has received a grant of \$850 from the Idyllwild Community Foundation for supplies and storage expense at the Community Center site.
- There are reports of graffiti being sprayed at the Dog Park. Linda will talk to Vic about possible remedies.
